Documentation you must provide with this application

- [] **Original National Police Certificate** (not more than three (3) months old at the time of application). (*Apply at participating Australia Post outlets in Western Australia on provision of identification and payment of the fee.*)
- [] If you have **not lived in Australia continuously for the last three (3) years** you will require both the equivalent clearance from the country you previously lived in and the above police clearances.
- [] **Certified copy of your photographic proof of identity.** (For example, drivers licence, proof of age card or passport). Your dealer can certify this identification, but it cannot be faxed as it must be clear enough to be able to recognise you. If you are unable to provide photographic proof of identity a certified copy of your birth certificate can be lodged.
- [] **Copy of Certificate of Competency on completion of the Motor Vehicle Salesperson Training Course.**
- [] **Application fee of \$261 is payable at the time of lodging an application** for a Motor Vehicle Salesperson's Licence with the Commissioner.
