You must advertise your intention to apply for a licence within **14 days after the receipt of the payment of your licence fee**. This time period is specified in the Land Valuers Licensing Regulations 1979. If this Regulation is breached Consumer Protection may require you to re-apply.

To place your advertisement, fax a copy of the entire LV2 form to *The West Australian* or *Sunday Times*. The advertisement is to be published in the Public Notices section and can be advertised on any day of the week. The original full page of the newspaper in which your advertisement appears is to be forwarded to Consumer Protection's Licensing and Registration Directorate, Locked Bag 14, Cloisters Square WA 6850.
