Thank you for providing the Consultation Regulatory Impact Statement (CRIS) on this regulatory proposal. The Regulatory Gatekeeping Unit (RGU) received the final CRIS on 11 July 2011.

The RGU advises that the *Regulatory Impact Assessment Guidelines for Western Australia* have been followed, and the Western Australian Government's Adequacy Criteria have been met.
